

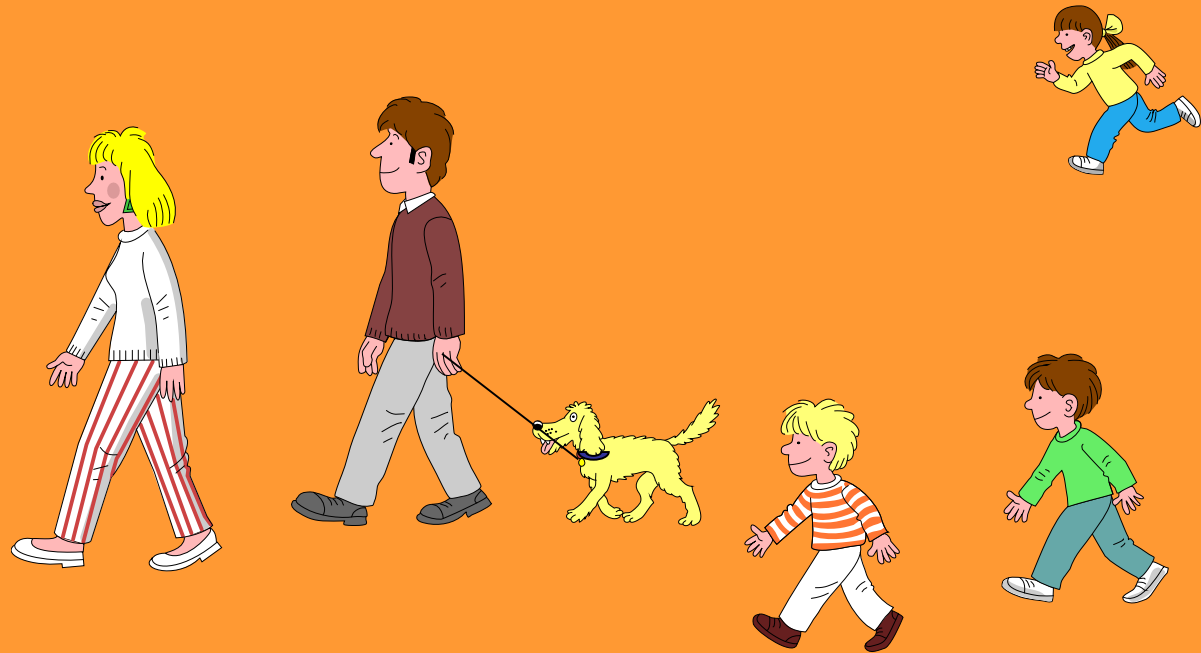
# A trip to the zoo

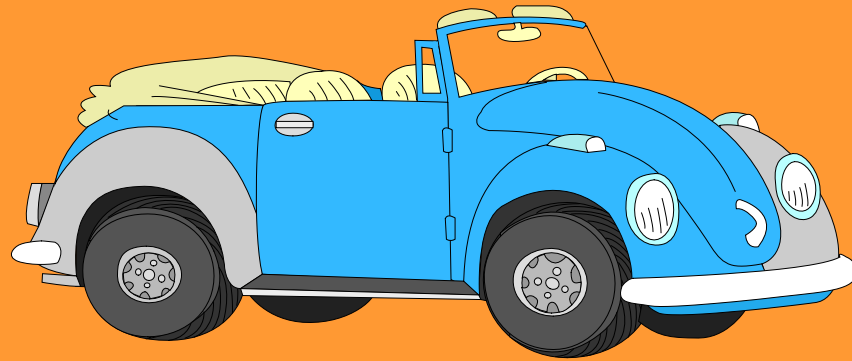

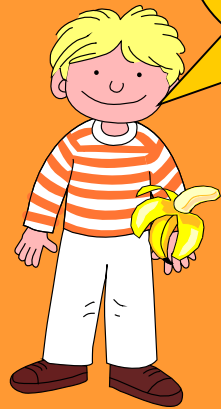

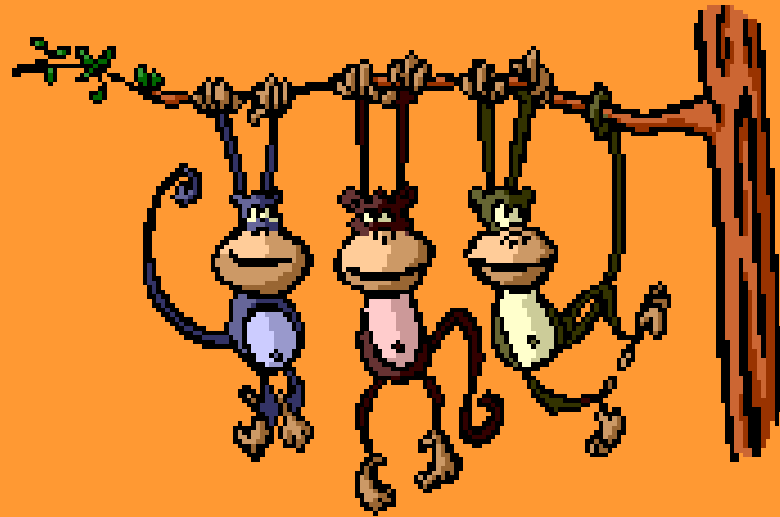
As soon as they were ready, they rushed out to the car. The sun was shining and the birds were singing. It was going to be a good day.

The camel had two humps.

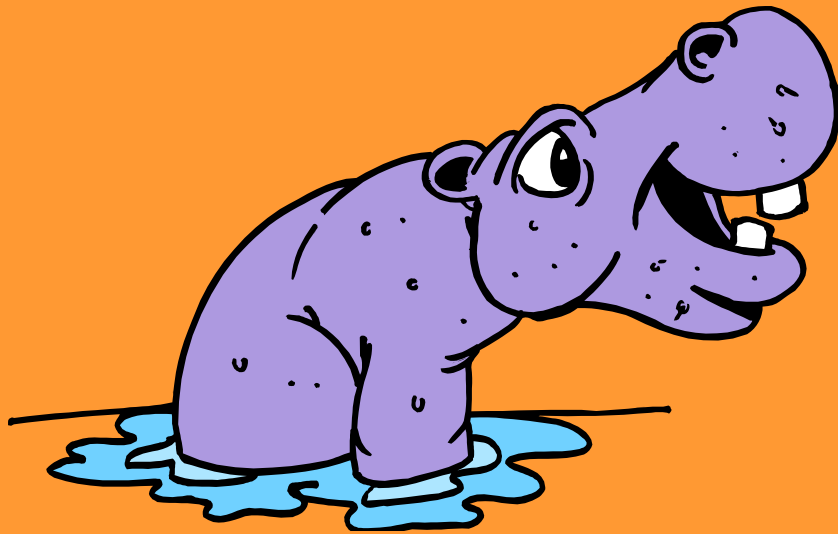

They were VERY tall.





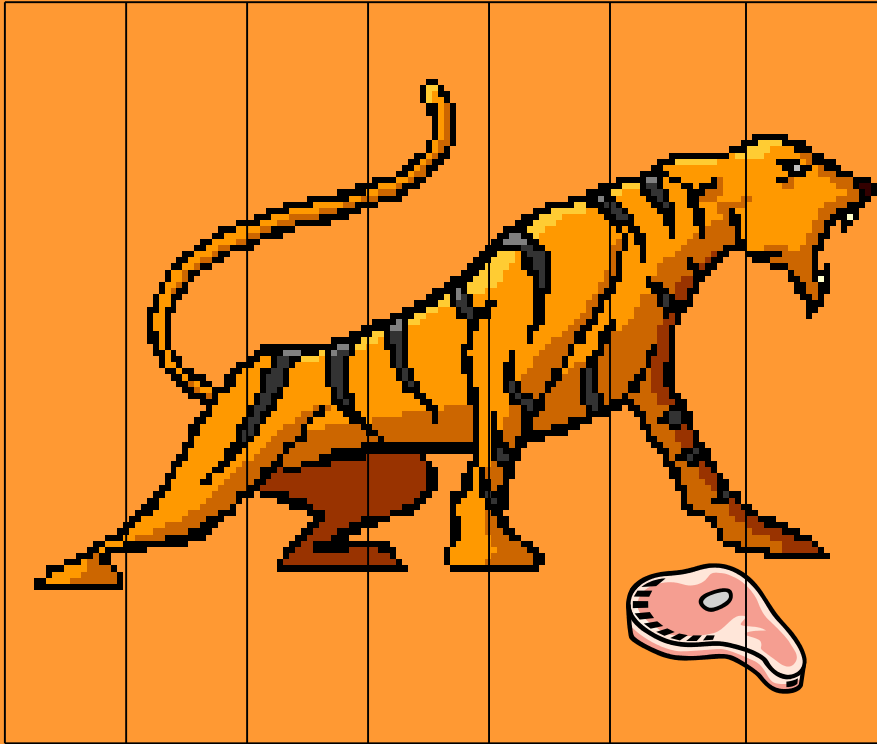

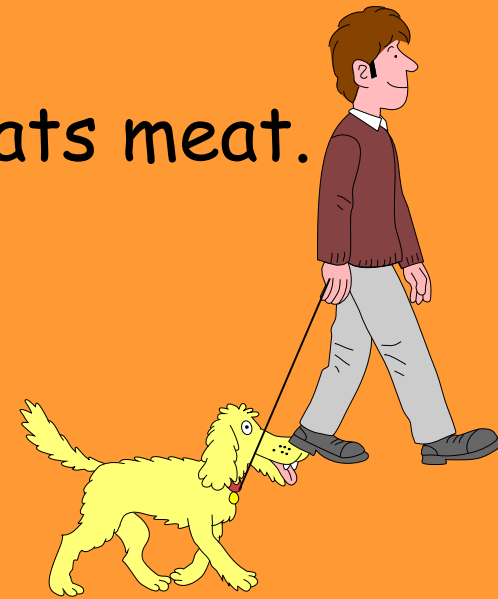
The hippopotamus eats grass.

He likes to cool down in the water.

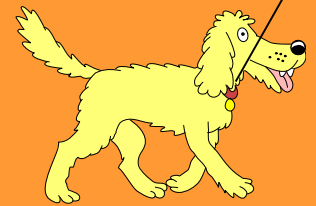
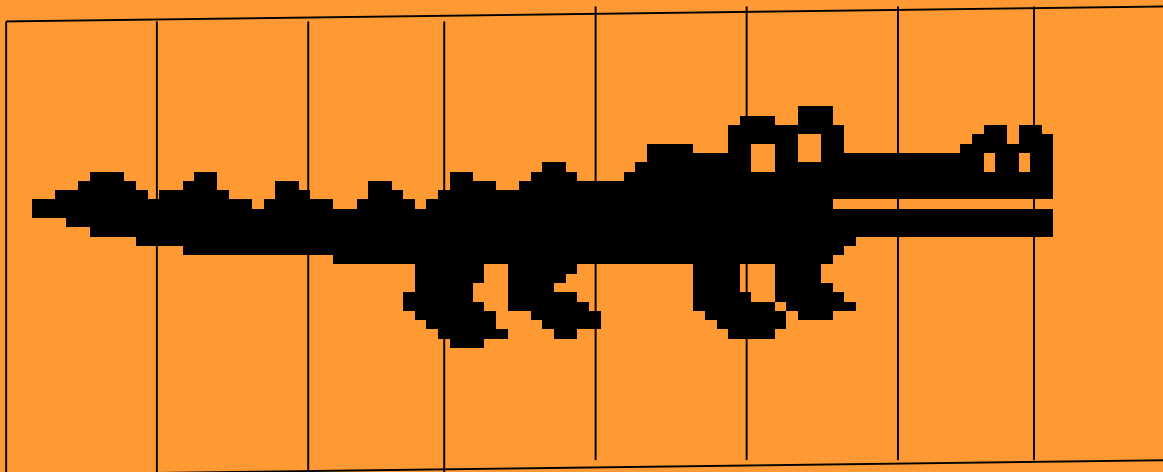
It was time to visit the big cats. First on the list was the tiger. Floppy was not keen on the tiger. He was used to chasing cats but thought this one would like to chase him!

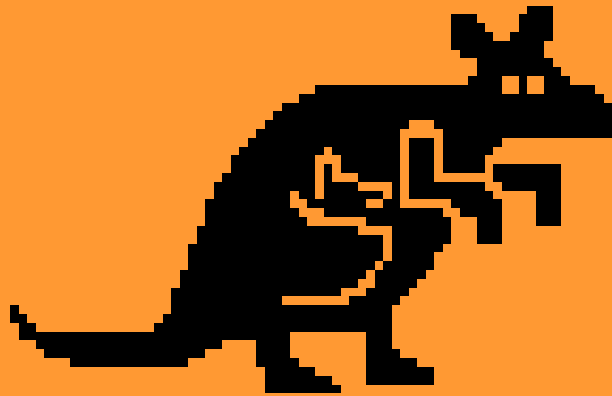


Floppy seemed much happier when they went to look at the pandas. One of the pandas was chewing on some bamboo and another was in a tree.
