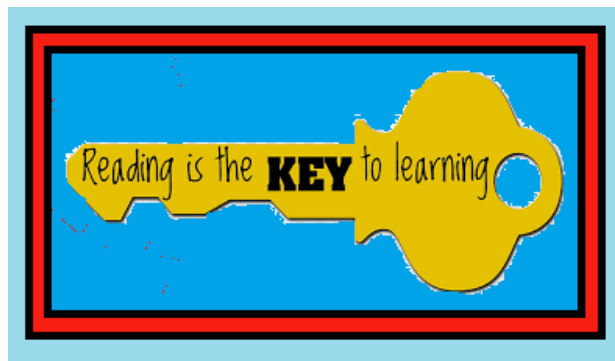


Phonics

Phonics at Poulton St.Chads CE is taught systematically using the 'Letters and Sounds' phonics programme to ensure full and consistent learning of the graphemes and their corresponding phonemes. We further support the children's learning by using the images and actions from 'Jolly Phonics' as a memory aid for all types of learners.



The children begin in Reception class with consolidating the skills learnt in Phase 1. They then work through Phases 2, 3 and 4. Then in Year 1 children consolidate their Phase 4 learning and learn Phase 5. In Year two they consolidate their Phase 5 knowledge before working through Phase 6 which includes spelling rules, prefixes, suffixes, and doubling letters.

Please note that in September 2020 all the children in KS1 will be taught to ensure their phonics knowledge is secure and that they are taught phonics at their level following the period of lockdown due to Covid 19.
