Keeping Safe

- ❖ The temperature within the classroom is likely to be cooler than normal in order to keep the space ventilated. It is advisable that the children wear a vest or t-shirt under their school shirt.
- ❖ We have plenty of hand sanitiser in school but children are welcome to bring their own to have in their tray.

Timetable Information

- ❖ **Monday** – Multiplication Books. Celebration Assembly.
- ❖ **Tuesday** – Children should attend school wearing their school PE kit. Trainers can be worn. They may also wear tracksuit bottoms and tops with the school emblem. Alternatively, plain, non-branded tracksuits with neutral colours (blue, black, grey) can be worn. Children with pierced ears need plasters in school if they are not able to remove their earrings as they will need to be covered during PE.
- ❖ **Wednesday** – From the second week back Year 4 will be going swimming for Autumn Term. A letter about this will be provided before the end of term.
- ❖ **Friday** – Spelling Books.

Water Bottles

- ❖ All children need a named water bottle in class, they should take this home every evening for washing.
- ❖ School policy is that juice/flavoured water is only permitted at lunchtime for children having packed lunches.

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Bags and Reading Books

- ❖ Book bags or flat messengers bags please as there isn't room in the coat cupboards for larger bags.
- ❖ Reading books should be brought into class each day.

Class Rewards

- ❖ Golden Book – this is an individual reward system where children can achieve golden points for a variety of things such as full marks in spelling tests and times tables tests, being kind, working hard, good listening, making good choices, having a helpful attitude...On Friday, the child with the most points is awarded a special certificate and sticker to take home.
- ❖ Lego reading wall – your child moves up their avatar each time they pass a reading quiz. When they have climbed to the top they will receive a prize. We all start at the beginning again every half term.
- ❖ Class Marbles – this is our class reward system and marbles are awarded when the class works well together, follows instructions, displays great team work...When our marble jar is full we get to have a treat afternoon.

Home Learning over Summer

- ❖ Please continue to practice your times tables. By the end of Year 4 you need to have rapid and secure recall of all tables to 12 x 12.
- ❖ Please complete a book review for the best book you read over the summer and bring it into class the first week back.
- ❖ The maths booklet is to help keep your place value knowledge secure and is it is best to do little and often over the holiday.
